

Dear Supporter,

GambleAware, formerly known as the Responsible Gambling Trust, is the leading charity in Great Britain committed to minimising gambling-related harm.

We are responsible for delivering many of the priority actions set out in the National Responsible Gambling Strategy 2016-19, published by the Responsible Gambling Strategy Board and endorsed by the Gambling Commission.

**Our aim is to stop people getting into problems with their gambling, and ensure that those who do develop problems receive fast and effective treatment and support.**

Our new five-year strategy, available on our website, renews our commitment to providing evidence-based research to identify what causes gambling-related harm, how best to minimise it, and which forms of treatment are most effective for problem gamblers.

The new strategy includes stretching targets for GambleAware, such as:

- Tripling the number of people benefiting from the national network of treatment services funded by GambleAware.
- Doubling the investment in harm-minimisation, particularly through the promotion of the GambleAware website as a source of advice and access to counselling.
- Increasing the research budget by 50%, spending £1.5m annually by 2018.
- Raising £10m a year from all those who profit from the gambling industry, including licence-holders, broadcast and online advertisers, and professional sports.

In order to raise £10million each year GambleAware is asking all organisations deriving an income from commercial gambling to **donate a minimum of 0.1% of their annual gross gambling yield (GGY)**. We ask all smaller gambling businesses with a GGY of less than £250,000 per annum to donate **a minimum of £250 per venue/activity**. We believe that this is a fairly modest request and one that all operators might accept is both reasonable and affordable.

GambleAware receives no public funding and relies on voluntary contributions from those who profit from the gambling industry in Great Britain. This donation-based system was proposed under the Gambling Act 2005 and is prescribed by the Gambling Commission in its Licence Conditions and Codes of Practice.

According to section 3.1.1 (2) of the Gambling Commission's revised Licence Conditions and Codes of Practice, which came into force on 8 May 2015, all *"licensees must make an annual financial contribution to one or more organisation(s) which between them research into the prevention and treatment of gambling-related harm, develop harm prevention approaches and identify and fund treatment to those harmed by gambling"*. In the event that this voluntary system fails to generate sufficient funds, the Gambling Act 2005 provides for a levy to be introduced on licensed operators.

As GambleAware funds education, prevention and treatment services, and commissions research to broaden public understanding of gambling-related harm, **an annual donation to our charity will fully discharge you from your obligations under section 3.1.1 (2) and provide you with a clear audit trail detailing your contribution.**

On receipt of your donation, GambleAware will send you a letter of confirmation and a receipted invoice. Please note that for donations of £250 and above you will also receive a 2016/17 donor certificate and the opportunity to use the GambleAware logo.
