Responsible Gambling Trust Harm Minimisation Conference registration is open

London, August 18: The Responsible Gambling Trust (RGT) has opened the registration for its fourth annual Harm Minimisation Conference on 7 & 8 December 2016.

The aim of the conference will be to review and discuss research, education and treatment in relation to minimising gambling-related harm in Great Britain. RGT conferences have been instrumental in shaping the direction of research and policy development, as well as informing industry practice in relation to promoting player protection and responsible gambling behaviour. This year, the conference will also be an opportunity to review and discuss best practice in treatment and harm minimisation.
