A. Part one: knowledge and experience

- Experience of designing, managing and/or commissioning projects and services in health settings.
- Knowledge and experience of project management is essential; a project management qualification is desirable.
- Knowledge and experience of performance management and quality assurance.
- Knowledge of gambling related harm or relevant field (for example, public health, health sociology, psychology) would be desirable.
- Knowledge and experience of using evidence to inform policy and practice.
- Experience of building positive relationships with a variety of stakeholders.
- An undergraduate degree in a relevant subject essential; a postgraduate qualification is desirable.
- Experience of close engagement with people with lived experience.

B. Part two: skills, abilities and personal style

- Excellent organisational skills, with ability to plan, anticipate problems and find solutions and deliver complex projects to tight deadlines.
- Ability to work under pressure, manage competing priorities and flexibly take up new tasks when required.
- Ability to work independently, with initiative and the ability to judge when to use it.

- Ability to analyse and synthesise complex information into key insights for a range of audiences.
- Sound financial aptitude and data skills.
