

Lived experience expertise required

GambleAware is currently looking for a small group of people to assist in assessing and scoring bids for a tender that will award a contract for the design and establishment of an inclusive GB-wide network of people with lived experience of gambling harms.

We would like to hear from you if you have direct lived experience of gambling harms, are an 'affected other', or identify as both. You must also be part of a formal or informal network or community of people with lived experience, so that you are able to contribute beyond your own personal experience. Ideally, but not essentially, you will also have some experience of the voluntary sector.

The time commitment is up to four days over three weeks split over the following activities.

1. A one-hour briefing session on Tuesday 3rd November
2. Reading and scoring bids individually, Wednesday 18th November
3. One-day panel workshop to score bids on Thursday 19th November
4. A half day for Presentations from Bidders on Wednesday 25th November

Remuneration is available for those not participating as part of a paid role (i.e. Individual rather than organisational remuneration). Participants will be selected to ensure a diversity of lived experiences, gender & ethnicity, and geography. We recognise this is by no means a perfect approach but in the absence of an inclusive, GB-wide network, we are taking a pragmatic approach. We hope this will be received in the spirit of inclusion in which it is intended.
